More to explore

With an abundance of outdoor activities and natural landscapes of raw beauty, Brisbane's Moreton Bay and Islands offers an energising getaway experience. Think island inspiration and coastal escape.

DAY ONE - MORETON BAY & ISLANDS

Delight in the fantastic array of marine life located around Brisbane with a cruise to Moreton Island - the world's third largest sand island.

Feel the thrill of quad-biking on beach and bushland trails and the adrenalin rush of sand-boarding down the impressive incline of Mount Tempest - the highest stabilised sand-dune in the world.

Experience the pure joy of handfeeding wild dolphins under the night stars.



DAY TWO - MORETON BAY & ISLANDS

Try a snorkelling or scuba diving excursion through the Tangalooma wrecks or enjoy the simple pleasure of a long walk on a long white sandy beach.

Discover the highlights of Moreton Island on a helicopter joy flight or a four wheel driving tour.

Visit the Tangalooma Marine Education and Conservation Centre for a guided walking tour and interactive presentation on island wildlife preservation.

DAY THREE - NORTH STRADBROKE ISLAND

Take a water taxi from Brisbane's bayside to Straddie (as it's known to locals) and explore the island's Indigenous and European history at the North Stradbroke Island Museum.

Visit the local art galleries and collect a unique piece of Indigenous artwork before heading to Point Lookout for an afternoon surfing lesson. Celebrate surfing success with a beachside picnic of fresh seafood straight from the trawler.



DAY FOUR - NORTH STRADBROKE ISLAND

Get active with Straddie Adventures. Try sea kayaking and snorkelling. Or dive into the underwater world with the team from the Manta Lodge & Scuba Centre.

Admire the spectacular views and beauty of nature along the North Gorge Headlands walk.

Hit the beaches and bushland around Blue Lake National Park on a four wheel driving tour.

DAY FIVE - COSTAL VILLAGES

Hire a car and delve into the charm and character of the coastal villages with a scenic drive along the tourist routes.

Join in the life of the esplanades with walking and cycling, windsurfing and fishing, picnics and play parks.

Include a trip to Sirromet Winery in the itinerary and indulge in a tasting tour and fine-dining at Restaurant Lurleen's.
