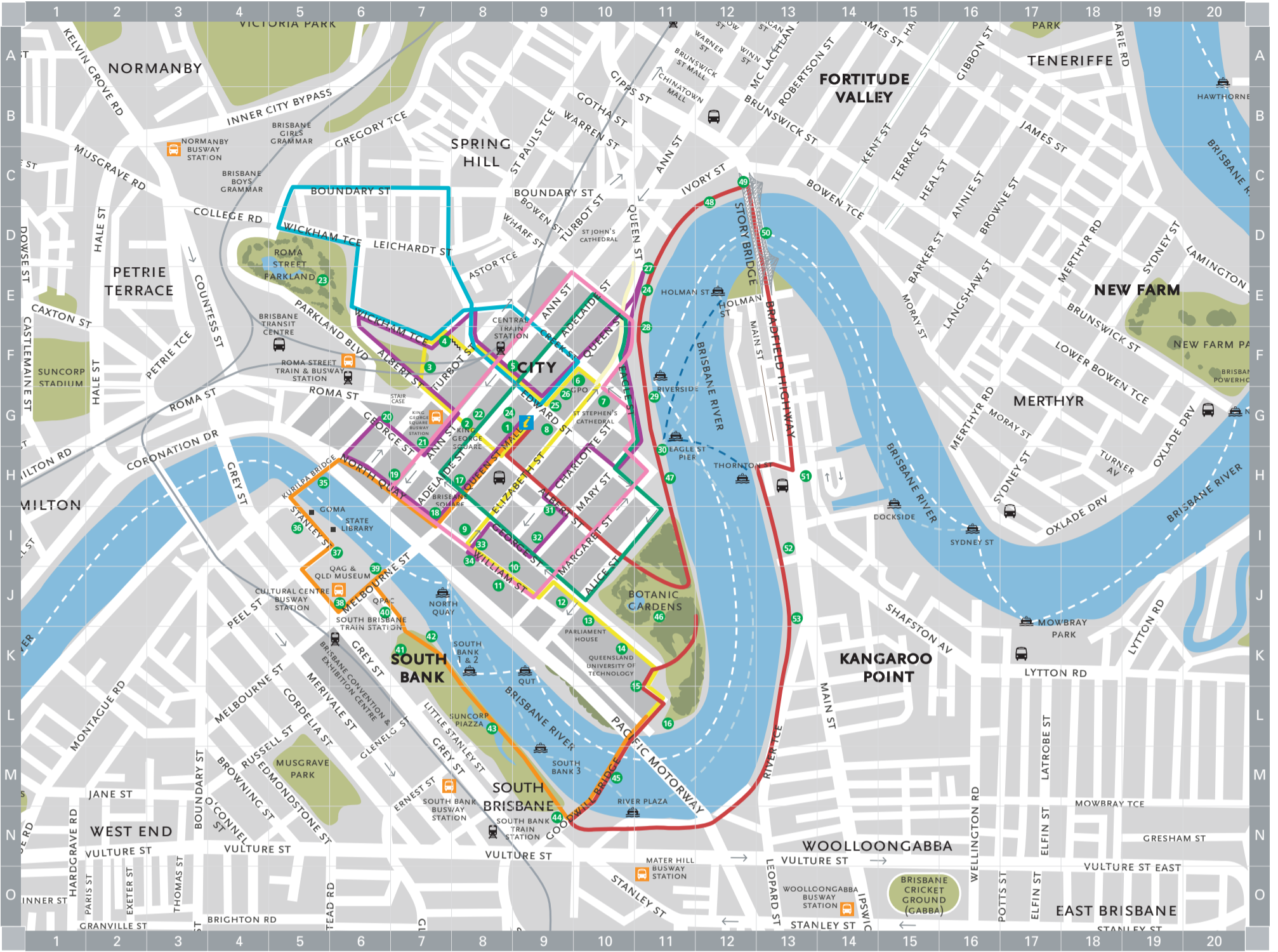

## ROUTE 1 - HISTORICAL TOUR

- 1. Queen Street Mall** - Over 1000 specialty stores and the Visitor Information and Booking Centre - ask friendly staff for advice or bookings.
- 2. Brisbane City Hall & King George Square**
- 3. The Old Windmill** - Built by convicts in 1828, it was used for both grinding corn and punishment.
- 4. Jacobs Ladder** - Built in 1961, the stairs link Wickham Terrace with Edward Street through King Edward Park.
- 5. Anzac Square memorial** - Dedicated to Australia's military heritage.
- 6. GPO Building** - Neo-classical architecture built in 1872.
- 7. Cathedral of St. Stephens** - A neo-gothic design built in 1850.
- 8. Macarthur Museum** - Dedicated to Brisbane's involvement in WWII.
- 9. Treasury Casino** - Originally the government's treasury.
- 10. Treasury Brisbane Hotel** - One of Australia's grandest heritage buildings.
- 11. Commissariat Store** - Originally built by convicts in 1829.
- 12. George Street Mansions** - Built in 1890 as 6 eloquent 3-storey terrace houses.
- 13. Parliament House** - French Renaissance style built in 1868.
- 14. QUT Art Museum** - A neo-classical revivalist design housing classic contemporary Australian art.

- 15. Old Government House** - Completed in 1862, a rare survivor from early colonial days.
- 16. River Mangrove Boardwalk** - Discover a rare ecosystem.

## ROUTE 2 - ART & ARCH. TOUR

- 1. Queen Street Mall** - See Route 1.
- 17. Scrap Metal Kangaroos** - The most photographed native animals in the city.
- 18. Brisbane Square** - Abstract modern forms.
- 19. Around the Camp Fires** - Sculptures - originally part of World Expo 1988.
- 20. Confluence** - Sophisticated artwork by Daniel Templeman.
- 21. The State Law Building** - A modern/gothic design nicknamed "The Batman Building."
- 22. King George Square** - Brisbane City Hall towers over the public-square.
- 23. Roma Street Parklands** - Spectacular sub-tropical gardens.
- 5. Anzac Square** - Dedicated to Australia's military heritage.
- 25. Dialogue** - Bronze sculptures more human than human!
- 26. The Overseer** - A delightfully human sculpture balancing over shoppers below.
- 27. Knots by Simon Perry** - Admiralty Towers.
- 24. Customs House** - A stunning neo-classical design built in the 1880's.

- 28. Chat** - A unique cast aluminium sculpture by Sebastian Di Mauro.
- 29. Riverside** - Take a walk along the Brisbane River promenade.
- 30. Waterfront Place** - One of Brisbane's landmark office towers.
- 31. Oaks Festival Towers** - A gallery honours the greats who played at Festival Hall.
- 32. Resonance** - An unusual Granite sculpture by Chee Fong Hew.
- 33. Queen Victoria Statue** - Centrepiece of Queens Park, completed in 1906.
- 34. Glass Mosaic** - A colourful design by Lindsay Edward.

## ROUTE 3 - CITY TO SOUTHBANK

- 1. Queen Street Mall** - See Route 1.
- 35. Kurilpa Bridge** - A pedestrian and bicycle bridge linking the city centre and South Brisbane.
- 36. GoMA** - Australia's largest Gallery of Modern Art.
- 37. State Library of Queensland** - Exhibitions, talks and tours, film screenings and school holiday workshops.
- 38. Queensland Museum & Science Centre** - Hands on encounters with fascinating Exhibitions and offers science based fun for kids of all ages.
- 39. Queensland Art Gallery** - Inspiring art collections.

- 40. Queensland Performing Arts Centre** - World-class entertainment.
- 41. Queensland Conservatorium** - One of Australia's leading tertiary music institutions.
- 42. Wheel of Brisbane** - Enjoy a panoramic view of the city and surrounds.
- 43. Southbank Parklands** - Lush gardens, food, shopping and Australia's only inner-city beach.
- 44. Queensland Maritime Museum** - Tour a 1945 Australian Navy frigate.
- 45. Goodwill Bridge** - A foot bridge linking the city with South Bank.

## ROUTE 4 - RIVER LOOP

- 1. Queen Street Mall** - See Route 1.
- 46. Botanic Gardens**
- 47. Take the Riverwalk** past Eagle Street Pier
- 24. Past Customs House**
- 48. Along the walkway** to the Story Bridge and Howard Smith Wharfs
- 49. Climb up Ivory Lane**
- 50. Across the Story Bridge**
- 51. Down Thornton Street Stairs** to the river walk
- 52. Past Riverlife Adventure Centre**
- 53. Kangaroo Point Cliffs**
- 45. Over the Goodwill Bridge** and back to the Botanic Gardens
